CURRICULUM

The Academy uses the A Beka System. We focus on a traditional approach to learning with a heavy emphasis on student / teacher interaction designed to meet each student's individual needs. Our curriculum includes comprehensive programs in **Systematic Phonics, Advanced Reading, Writing, Mathematics, Art and Music Appreciation, and Computer Studies**, using the latest technology.

Registration is for the entire year and includes a non-refundable, non-transferable registration fee of **\$150.00** per child. This fee covers student's insurance, book keeping fees, and associated costs for providing our informative monthly school newsletter. This fee is due in September of each school year.

Book Fees range from \$75 to \$250 per year. Please see the Book Fee List.

Tuition: Students aged 18 months through K4 are \$145.00 per week, with the first and last weeks' tuitions due in advance. Please, see the office for detailed information about tuition for full time students K5 and up.
